

## **Don's Club Meeting Minutes Wednesday, October 14, 2009**

**Call to Order: 6:08pm**

**Minutes Review:** Minutes from Sept 9<sup>th</sup> meeting were Approved

**Membership Report:** (Liz Aitchison)

- 168 members (not including coaches)
- 69 Family, 10 Single, 1 Alumni, 6 Grandparent, 4 Family Lifetime, 5 donations@50  
Total Membership Income = \$4,310.00.

**Treasurer's Report:** (Marcie Colonna)

- End of September Balance: \$14,880.09  
Noting that we owe ½ of Membership to ASB – agreed to pay sooner than later.
- Treasurers report includes Income = \$8,366.82, Expenses = \$2,342.57

**Funding Requests:**

- Deb Haggard requested funds for (1) stunt mat for the cheerleading teams. Proposed: NTE \$850 if Don's get 8 hours of cheer parent snack shack volunteers a month. Funds approved but no request yet. Still waiting for mats to ship.
- Roberto and Lilian Mata requested funds to help with a dinner & dance fundraiser for Del Mar parents to be held on December 12. Tickets \$20pp or \$35 couple. They are asking \$300 from each group and the return will be divided equally. This event will bring Del Mar parents and community together and raises funds for Del Mar Org.

Alan Motioned to approve funds of \$300 to Roberto and Lilian Mata as long as it is funded through an organization of Del Mar. Motion approved! Lilian and Roberto are also helping with translating

Don's information (membership form) from English to Spanish. This is greatly appreciated to reach our Spanish speaking families.

**Old Business:**

- Football snack shack – Prices are low compared to other schools. Added a meal deal. Increased polish to \$5, added large hot dog \$4. May sell churros – Buy 200 @ .50, Sell for \$1 = \$100.00 profit
- San Jose Water Co. application grant – Sue to turn in – Still need more grants
- Volleyball snack shack – Made \$143 and \$81. Not as much to sell. May add potatoes to offer more.
- ASB is asking for \$5K now and \$5K later this year. Mr. Russell still collecting the requested information. (Move to Nov meeting)
- Discussions regarding ASB situation. ASB was run poorly.
