General Membership Meeting

Monday, July 9, 2007

1. **Call To Order-** Meeting was called to order by President Araujo @ 6:20 pm.
Attendance- John Araujo, Steve Ode, Matthew Dean, Sue Bergschneider, Tammy Holm; Eric Buran; Andy Masterbone;
2. **Minutes Review-** Minutes from June 11, 2007 were reviewed.
MS/C- Dean/ Bergschneider To approve minutes for June as submitted.
3. **Membership Report-** Condie- Received \$50 check from Mark Bara (Roller Hockey club). This will be for membership for year. Roller Hockey is not official school sport but a club; therefore Bara does not receive "coach" status and free membership.
4. **Treasurer's Report-** Ode
 - a. new signature card- Masterbone and Schauer reminded to visit Comerica Bank on Winchester Blvd and add their names to the signature card for Dons sports association.
 - b. Ode reported balance of \$7,798.32 as of June 30, 2007. \$900 was received from the BVAL golf tournament as Del Mar's part. We also will be receiving \$400 from last spring's BVAL All Star Basketball game held at Del Mar (Holm) and will receive \$3,000 from PTA from left over monies from previous graduation nights (Dean). It was also requested to get a complete financial printout and (1) place it on the website; (2) get copy to Bergschneider in order to be able to solicit sponsorships (3) copy to Araujo to submit to CUHSD with official request for Booster Club application to district.
MS/C- Masterbone/Holm; To accept the Treasurer's report as submitted.
5. **Old Business-**
 - a. **Website Information Update-** Discussion centered on what items to place on the Website. It was decided to place: monthly calendar of major school events/sports calendar; post the financial statement (budget); include articles from the school newspaper reported by student staff relating to student achievements including sports, awards, scholarships, etc. It was felt that items placed on the website need to stay current and relevant.
 - b. **Football lights/night games-** At this point in time, the CUHSD is sticking by their schedule for installation of lights. There is not guarantee as to when the lights will be operational. The hope is that by mid October so that several games will be placed under the lights. District is also adamant with regard to no portable lights be used for any games.

Football coaching staff felt it would be best to follow the schedule as currently listed for the season and when the lights are installed, then some games may be switched to night action.

Homecoming game was discussed and it was recommended that the procession of the Homecoming court be done before the marching band so as to ensure the court gets a chance to be recognized. Last year, the band portion ran too long and the court was not able to parade and be recognized.
